Volunteer Job List

<p>Food Packagers: A group of 120. We need 10 people for 12 tables. This group will package the meals. This group is needed from 12:45pm - 2pm. This group should consist of volunteers of all ages. No children younger than 7. Children will need adult supervision.</p>

In Group: A group of 3 to help unload the truck beginning at 10:00am. This group will unload the trailer, equipment and food ingredients and bring them into the Skate Center. This group will be needed from 10 - 11am. This group needs to be older HS students or adults.

Set Up: A group of 12 to set up the tables. This group will work from 10:30am -11:30pm. This group will set the equipment out on to the tables, set the food bins on each table and then load the bins with the proper ingredients. This group will also make boxes. This group could be made up of children in their MS years or older. Children will need adult supervision.

Greeter and Registration: A group of 2 that will collect funds, check in pre-registered volunteers, and register new volunteers. This group is needed from 12 - 2pm. This group should be made up of adults.

Staging/Scheduler: A group of 3 that will organize packaging volunteers into groups of 10, in a staging area, near the registration tables. They will also provide the volunteers with aprons and hair nets and direct them to their station. This group is needed from 12:30 - 2:30pm. This group should be made up of HS students or older.

Station Coordinators: A group of 12, one Station Coordinator per work station. This group is needed for the entire event, starting at 11:00am until finished (approximately 2:30pm). They will help prepare the tables and will explain to volunteers how to do each job at the station and ensure the job is performed correctly. This group should be made up of HS students or older.

Runners: A group of 3-7. This group will continually supply the tables with the light ingredients; beans, flavoring, etc. This group is needed from 12:30 to 2:30pm. This group should be made up of HS students or older.

Product Prep: A group of 3-4. This group will continually unload product; open bags, fill totes and remove bags to trash cans. Works with Runners to tape the boxes closed and transport them to and load them on the pallets. This group is needed from 12:30 to 2:30pm. This group will need to lift heavy items (50lbs of beans) so it should be older HS students or adults.

Clean Up: A group of 12. This group will wipe down the tables before they are put away and any equipment according to Outreach, Inc. instructions. This group will put the tables away, sweep the floor, take the trash out and do any other necessary cleaning. This group is needed from 2 - 3pm. This group could be MS students or older.

Loaders: A group of 3. This group will collect boxed meals, load pallets with boxed meals, load pallets into trucks. This group is needed from 1 - 3pm. The group should consist of HS students with adult supervision.
